"DALEJ NA PÓŁNOC ROWEREM SIĘ NIE DA" cyclo-cross, a UCI Category 2 event for Elite Men, Elite Women, Junior WOMAN and Junior Men and for younger polish categories, Masters and amateurs takes place on Saturday, 17 November, 2024, and which is organized by **Klub Sportowy Klif Chłapowo** 

The races are organized according to the regulations of the UCI and Polish Cycling (PZKoI).

### 2. PROGRAM

### 3. REGULATIONS

1. The organization of the "DALEJ NA PÓŁNOC ROWEREM SIĘ NIE DA", class 2 cyclo-cross event on the international UCI calendar, is carried out by Klub Sportowy Klif Chłapowo under the regulations of the UCI & Polish Cycling (PZKoI).

The races, run on Sunday, November 17, 2024, in Cetniewo-Władysławowo, will be contested under UCI regulations.

- 2. The main races are reserved for UCI Elite Women /Junior Woman OPEN and UCI Elite Men. Also on the program are a UCI race for Junior Men, as well as National races.
- 3. Jury members will be welcomed at 7:00a.m. at the race office, OPO Cetniewo , Żeromskiego 52 Street in Władysławowo, where the technical meeting with the UCI commissaire will take place followed by the course check (~7:15 a.m.).
- 4. Registration and distribution of bibs will begin at 7:30 a.m. until no more than one hour before the start of the respective categories. The registration office is located in OPO Cetniewo Żeromskiego 52 Street in Władysławowo.

- 5. Parking for elite riders is located at OPO Cetniewo Żeromskiego 52 Street in Władysławowo and near the course at all Sportowa Street in Władysławowo (map info)
- 6. The anti-doping control will take place in OPO Cetniewo Żeromskiego 52 Street in Władysławowo. Specific regulations apply for anti-doping control.
- 7. Breaches of the regulations for the UCI races will be penalized according to the official UCI regulations and penalty scale. All disputes will be settled by the president and the members of the jury, in accordance with UCI regulations.
- 8. The award ceremony for the UCI: 6 Elita Men, Elita Women OPEN, U 19 Men riders of each race will take place as soon as possible and no later than 15 minutes after the finish of the first rider (per category). U19 Women 3 place (furthermore)

## 4. PRIZE MONEY

Elite Men / Women (total 7 800 PLN per category):

1700-900-650-500-450-400-370-340-320-300-270-250-220-200-180-150-150-150-150-150.

Junior Men (total 4 000 PLN per category):

750-500-400-350-250-250-250-200-200-200-150-150-150-150-150.

The rider's contribution to Anti-Doping to 2% is included in the Prize Money. It should be deducted from the PM paid to the riders.

IMPORTANT: All cash prizes will be transferred to the bank accounts provided by the athletes after

the decoration ceremony. Competitors must provide their bank details to the Race Office for the transfer of prize money.



# 7. COURSE AND PLAN

The course distance = 2500 m.

The course is located in OPO Cetniewo in Władysławo. The start area is about 100 meters before the finish line.

90% of the course is earth, grass, 5 % paving Stones, 5% sea sand



### 8. RACE OFFICE

To have access to the elite car parking and the circuit, riders must present themselves at registration:

7:30 on Sunday (17 November) they can collect their race number and shoulder numbers.

### 11.80%

During the UCI races the 80% rule may be applied. If pulled by an official, riders can exit the circuit before they enter the finish line. The withdrawal of the riders will take place outside the view of the television camera recording the finish line.
